

Passenger Preflight Briefing



Prior to takeoff, the Pilot-in-Command must ensure that all passengers have been briefed on:

- This flight is being conducted under a FAA authorized grand-of-exemption as the aircraft and flight crew are not under a commercial carrier.
- This aircraft has been maintained according to requirements in the Federal Air Regulations for private aircraft, not as a commercial carrier.
- That smoking is not allowed in or around the aircraft.
- That seat belts and shoulder harnesses are required for take-off and landing.
- That aisles and walkways remain clear during takeoff and landing. Seat backs, tray tables or other equipment be stowed.
- The locations and operation of all exits on the aircraft.
- The location and operation of any survival equipment on the aircraft.
- For a passenger needing assistance exiting the aircraft, a procedure for the assistant to follow if emergency evacuation is necessary.
- The requirement for a sterile cockpit during; taxi, takeoff, climb, decent, and landing. Discuss there should be only essential communications during these times, that unnecessary flight crew distractions are detrimental to the safety of the flight.
